Contractor did not receive all of the required inspections from the City of Pleasanton Building Inspection Department during the course of the construction project. Specifically, Contractor failed to obtain the following inspection(s):

- An inspection related to the “tear-off” of the old roof and inspection of roof rafters. This includes, but is not limited to, broken rafters, dry rot damage, and repairs or replacements where needed for broken and/or damaged rafters on the roof and/or eaves.
- An inspection related to the decking material installed over the rafters. This includes, but is not limited to, the type of decking material used, the spacing of decking material used on the rafters to allow for expansion and contraction, the attachment of the decking material to the existing roofing structure, type of attachment materials used, and the size or gauge of attachment materials.

The City is willing to allow for such work to remain, but expressly does not approve such work because all of the required inspections were not obtained by the Contractor. As a condition of granting this special consideration the City may require a portion of the work to be removed for partial inspection.

Contractor shall indemnify and hold the City harmless from and against any suits, claims, injuries or damages of any kind whatsoever, including the cost of defense of any action brought against the City, arising out of the fact that all of the required inspections were not obtained by the Contractor.
