Richard Fey has a degree from Simpson College and has attended various courses at Yale Summer School of Music & Art, Indiana University and the Italian cultural Institute in Florence, Italy. He has traveled extensively performing in locations ranging from the Berlin Volkfest to concert halls and military bases. His performance repertoire includes Don Quixote in “Man of La Mancha,” Figaro in both the Rossini and Mozart versions of the opera, and many other operatic and musical theater roles. Mr. Fey is a member of the Bay Area Professional Singers’ Forum and a graduate of the Merola Program of San Francisco Opera. He is currently on the faculty of the Community Music Center in San Francisco.

Chun Mei Wilson, the pianist, has been a judge for competitions and evaluator for Certificate of Merit for 10 years. She apprenticed as a prompter at San Francisco Opera and for many years has accompanied for Festival Opera, North Bay Opera, Livermore Valley Opera and Martinez Opera. She had coached the world-renowned Frederica Von Stade from 1997 till the mezzo’s Carnegie Hall farewell recital in 2010. Ms. Wilson graduated from UC Berkeley with a double major in music and linguistics and received her Master of Music degree in piano performance from New England Conservatory in Boston.
