IDEAS FOR COLLECTING FOOD SCRAPS

COLLECT FOOD SCRAPS IN MILK OR ICE CREAM CARTONS. PLACE FULL CARTONS IN THE GREEN CART.
WRAP FOOD SCRAPS IN NEWSPAPER.
REUSE PAPER BAGS AS SCRAP BAGS.
