

Why License?

- Identification on your dog's collar can save your pet's life should your pet become lost or injured.
- Licensing verifies your dog has a current rabies vaccination. This is important if your dog is involved in a bite or has contact with a wild animal.
- Avoid citations that start at \$100 per unlicensed dog.
- Licensing is required by law!

Dog License Application



Pleasanton Municipal Code
Dog Licensing:

7.12.010 Required.

Every person within the area owning, possessing, controlling, harboring, or keeping any dog over four months of age shall procure a dog license tag for each dog, as long as ownership of the dog continues, or within ten days after acquiring or bringing into the area any dog, over the age of four months, and annually thereafter, so long as the ownership of the dog continues.

7.12.050 Rabies Vaccination Required.

As a condition for the issuance of a license, all applicants for such license shall procure and deliver to the licensing authority a certificate issued by a duly licensed veterinarian certifying that the dog to be licensed has been administered an anti-rabies vaccination within thirty days prior to the issuance of said license, or has received anti-rabies vaccination sufficient to immunize said dog against rabies for the current license period.

Licensing Terms Available:

You may license your dog for one, two, or three years based on the date your dog's rabies vaccination expires.

Note: You may only license for the period remaining on the dog's rabies vaccination. (Fees are based on one year increments - no partial years).

Dog License Fees:

Your dog's license fee is determined by the term of the license you choose, and whether or not your dog is spayed or neutered. If your dog is a **spayed** female or a **neutered** male, the licensing fee is reduced. **See table - above right.**

Dog License Fees:

Term	1 year	2 year	3 year
<u>Spayed</u> female	\$3.50	\$6.50	\$9.00
<u>Neutered</u> male	\$3.50	\$6.50	\$9.00
Intact female	\$7.00	\$13.00	\$18.00
Intact male	\$7.00	\$13.00	\$18.00
