

RESOLUTION NO. 15-766

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLEASANTON TO STOP THE EAST PLEASANTON SPECIFIC PLAN (EPSP) PLANNING AND ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW PROCESS; HAVE THE EPSP PROCESS CONSIDERED AS PART OF THE CITY COUNCIL'S REGULAR PRIORITY SETTING; AND STOP WORK, THANK AND DISBAND THE EPSP TASK FORCE

WHEREAS, the City of Pleasanton's General Plan Land Use Program 6.1 discusses the preparation of a Specific Plan for East Pleasanton, and in 2012 the City began a study for the East Pleasanton Specific Plan (EPSP) area, and created a task force to assist in planning and environmental review; and

WHEREAS, the planning process has involved a significant effort by task force members, as well as members of the public, to become informed about the EPSP, as well as an investment by property owners to pay for City staff to coordinate environmental review; and

WHEREAS, while the efforts of the involved residents, community members, property owners, task force members, members of the public and other officials has brought forward important information, the City Council will stop its consideration of the EPSP and related EIR due to a range of community concerns.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLEASANTON DOES RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE AND ORDER THE FOLLOWING:

SECTION 1. Stop the planning process for the East Pleasanton Specific Plan and the related environmental review process.

SECTION 2. Any future decision to restart the EPSP process shall occur as part of future regular City Council priority setting meetings.

SECTION 3. Acknowledge all of the time and effort of the EPSP Task Force members, thank them for their service, and stop further work and disband the EPSP Task Force.
