Bank Robbery



On June 3, 2016 at 10:50 AM a robbery occurred at the Wells Fargo Bank located at 4767 Hopyard Road. A male suspect approached a teller window and provided a note demanding cash. The note indicated the suspect had a firearm, but a firearm was not seen or displayed. The suspect exited the bank and fled in a dark gray or dark silver Audi A3. Several witnesses saw the vehicle driving south on Hopyard Road and then into downtown Pleasanton. He turned from Main Street onto westbound Bernal Avenue in the eastbound lanes until the intersection of Valley Avenue. The suspect re-entered the westbound lanes of Bernal Avenue where Pleasanton



Police Officers began pursuing him as he continued to northbound Interstate 680. The suspect continued to drive in a manner that was unsafe for the public and pursuing officers and Pleasanton Police Officers terminated the pursuit. The suspect was last seen driving westbound on Interstate 580. As of this time the suspect or his vehicle was not located.

The suspect was described as approximately 6'2" tall, stocky build, wearing blue jeans, a black colored sweatshirt with the hood pulled onto his head, and a white cloth material was wrapped around his head covering the face. He was also wearing dark sunglasses.

The suspect's vehicle was described as a dark gray or dark silver Audi A3 Sportback with dealer or obscured license plates.

Pleasanton Police Department detectives are working with other agencies to determine if this incident is related to other similar incidents in the Bay Area.

Wells Fargo is offering \$5,000 reward for information that leads to the identification, arrest and conviction of the suspect.
