Stolen Vehicle Suspect Arrested

On November 15, 2016 around 1030 hours, Officer White was patrolling the parking lot of the Wal-Mart Market located at 3112 Santa Rita Road when he noticed a suspicious vehicle (1997 Acura Integra) that was reported stolen. Within a few minutes, Officer White observed 4 individuals walking towards the vehicle. The subjects entered the vehicle and drove off. As the vehicle turned north onto Santa Rita Road, Officer White initiated a traffic stop on the driver of the vehicle. The driver did not stop and continued north on Santa Rita Road at a high rate of speed. As the vehicle approached Pimlico Drive, it drove across the center median and entered the east bound I-580 off ramp into oncoming traffic. Due to public safety concerns, all Pleasanton Police units terminated the pursuit of the vehicle. The suspect vehicle drove approximately ¼ mile the wrong direction on I-580 before stopping on the shoulder.

All four occupants exited the vehicle and began running towards Rosewood Drive. Pleasanton Police units responded and immediately detained three subjects from the vehicle, all of whom were juveniles. The fourth outstanding suspect was seen running into a storage facility in the area. A perimeter was quickly established and a Pleasanton Police K-9 unit responded and searched the interior of the storage facility. The Police K-9 unit located the suspect hiding in an enclosed area and was subsequently arrested without incident.

The suspect has been identified as Roberto Razo (01/17/94). Razo was arrested for possession of a stolen vehicle (10851 CVC), evading a Police Officer while driving into opposite traffic (2800.4 CVC), child endangerment (273(a) PC) and resisting arrest (148(a)(1) PC).
