### Fatal Traffic Collision-Hopyard Rd./Owens Dr.

On Tuesday, April 4, 2017 at about 6:13 PM, Pleasanton Police Officers responded to a report of a collision involving three vehicles near the intersection of Hopyard Road and Owens Drive. On arrival, officers discovered that a Toyota Rav 4 had collided with a Subaru Outback. Both vehicles sustained major damage as a result of this collision. A Nissan Versa was also involved in this collision which had moderate damage. The initial investigation indicates the Toyota was traveling northbound on Hopyard Road when it collided with the Subaru which was turning onto eastbound Owens Drive from Hopyard Road.

One of the passengers in the Subaru, a 61 year old Pleasanton resident, suffered major injuries as a result of this collision. Life saving measures were attempted on the passenger and she was transported to Eden Medical Center where she succumbed to her injuries. The driver of the Subaru sustained major injuries and was transported to John Muir Hospital where he is recovering. There was also an infant in the Subaru who was properly restrained in an infant car seat and sustained only minor injuries. She was transported to Children's Medical Center where she was treated and released.

The driver and passenger of the Toyota sustained non-life threatening injuries and were transported to Eden Medical Center. The driver was released from the hospital and the passenger is still recovering from her injuries. The driver of the Nissan was not injured and was released from the scene.

The Hopyard Road and Owens Drive intersection was partially closed for a few hours as investigators from the Pleasanton and Livermore Police Department's MAIT (Major Accident Investigation Team) investigated this fatal collision.
