Pleasanton Police Offer Mobile App

Pleasanton, Calif. – The Pleasanton community can now be more connected to the police department thanks to a free new mobile app. The Pleasanton Police Department is excited to offer the app, which allows users to submit crime tips, receive alerts and view other department information.

The app also provides access to the department's social media feeds, recruitment announcements, safety tips and media releases. Other features include a link to the department's online reporting system and a unique property function that allows users to log property (including photos). The property log may be exported and given to police in the event of burglary or theft.

While users can submit tips (including an option to submit them anonymously) the app is not intended to replace 911, which community members should still call immediately if there is an emergency or a crime in progress. Using the "Submit a Tip" feature, app users can report abandoned vehicles, animal nuisances, graffiti and suspected drug activity (not in progress). If desired, photos can be submitted with the tip.

"Our goal is to encourage a deeper connection between the police department and the Pleasanton community," said Chief David Spiller. "The app offers access to the police department in a way the community is most comfortable engaging – through their phones."

The free mobile app was developed by Apex Mobile (formerly Cloudspace Mobile) and is available for download on Apple and Android devices via the iOS App Store and the Google Play Marketplace; simply search for "Pleasanton Police".
