Attempted Armed Robbery PPD Case #17-34523

On the September 4, 2017, at about 10:53 P.M., two female Pleasanton residents were walking in the Pleasanton Place Apartments complex, located at 4408 Mohr Ave, when a male approached them from behind. The male pointed a black gun at one of the victims and demanded she give him her gold necklace. When she hesitated, the male suspect swiped at the victim's neck and attempted to take the chain by force. The suspect was unable to grab the necklace and fled on foot eastbound on Mohr Ave. He is described as a clean shaven black male, about 6'3" tall and weighing about 200 pounds with short black hair and in his late twenties or early thirties. He was wearing a dark colored ¾ zip sweatshirt and black pants. There was no associated vehicle or additional suspects seen.

Officers arrived on-scene in less than two minutes and conducted an extensive area search, but were unable to capture the suspect. The victims were uninjured in the attempted robbery.
