Student Arrested on School Campus

Student had loaded handgun on Village High School Campus

Pleasanton, Calif. – On October 23, 2017 at 11:16am the Pleasanton Police Department responded to Village High School after school officials reported a student was possibly in possession of a concealed handgun on campus. When officers arrived they contacted the student, who was in possession of a loaded handgun. No other weapons were located.

The student was immediately placed under arrest for 626.9 PC, possession of a firearm on school grounds, and was transported to Juvenile Hall without incident. It is unknown why the student had the handgun.

The Pleasanton Police Department and The Pleasanton Unified School District continue to work together to maintain safety at all Pleasanton schools. Over the past several years both organizations have partnered to train for various scenarios, including recognizing suspicious activity and how to report it.

As a reminder, the Pleasanton Police Department encourages community members to report suspicious activity. Both the police department and Pleasanton Unified School District maintain anonymous tip lines that can be called anytime.
