Passport Applications Now Accepted in City Clerk's Office

Citizens of the United States who are planning international travel may apply for passports by making an online appointment on the Clerk's webpage.

Passport applications will be accepted by appointment only and walk-in service will not be available. Appointments can be made online through the City Clerk's Passport Services webpage at cityofpleasantonpassports.org and appointments can be scheduled Monday through Thursday, 10:30-11:30 a.m. and 1:30-4 p.m. The City does not process renewal forms (DS-82), only new applications (DS-11).
