STATEMENT ON THE PASSING OF SANDRA ROY THORNE

City Flags at Half-Staff in Honor of Mayor's Wife

PLEASANTON, Calif. — The wife of Mayor Jerry Thorne, Sandra Roy Thorne, passed away this morning.

Born on August 14, 1937, Sandi and Jerry Thorne settled in Pleasanton, where they raised their daughter, Keri, who with her husband and two children, was at Sandi's side these past few weeks.

As the First Lady of Pleasanton, Sandi was a stalwart supporter of the Mayor and all his work, but she championed her own causes as well. She was on the Board of Directors at the Museum on Main, and she was also actively engaged in the Assistance League of Amador Valley.

“It is with great sadness that I share the passing of Sandi Thorne, who died unexpectedly. Sandi was a devoted wife and mother and a great friend to our community. I have directed all City flags be flown at half-staff through the weekend in honor of Sandi and her significant contributions to our City.
