### **ALVISO ADOBE COMMUNITY PARK CELEBRATES 10<sup>TH</sup> ANNIVERSARY**

This fully restored interpretative park reveals the history of the Amador Valley, and the event will highlight the three time periods of the Adobe Site: Ohlone, Californio, and the Meadowlark Dairy. Attendees will enjoy authentic historical music, wish happy birthday to Fiona the milking cow, and participate in hands-on activities and presentations from historical experts.

The celebration will highlight the *fandango*, a widely popular festivity during the rancho period. Like a typical *fandango*, participants will enjoy music, dancing, food and great company to celebrate Pleasanton's history.
