### Overnight Theft Series & Altercation

On the morning of November 9, 2019 at about 5:45 AM, a resident on Via Di Salerno in the Ruby Hill Community awoke to the sound of his vehicle being started in front of his home. The resident exited his home and observed his vehicle being backed out of his driveway. The resident entered another vehicle and gave chase as both vehicles traveled north on E. Ruby Hill Drive. As the vehicles approached the main gate near Vineyard Avenue the stolen vehicle left the roadway and collided with a pole, where it came to rest. The victim and suspect engaged in a brief, physical altercation and the suspect ultimately fled.

Officers from the Pleasanton Police Department immediately responded. A Livermore Police Department K9 unit and an ACSO drone team arrived and an extensive search for the suspect was conducted. Search efforts continued for over an hour, however, the suspect was not located. Several pieces of evidence were located at the scene including mail stolen from five other Ruby Hill residents. Another vehicle burglary which occurred overnight was discovered and all of the crimes are suspected of being related to the same suspect.

The suspect is described as a White male, twenty to thirty years old, approximately 180 pounds, last seen wearing a dark colored hoodie. The Pleasanton Police Department is actively following up on several leads. Video surveillance of the suspect was obtained from earlier in the night and is attached to this press release.
