Attempted Traffic Stop Leads to Vehicle Pursuit

On February 19, 2020, at approximately 12:06 a.m., Pleasanton police officers attempted a traffic stop on a white Ford F-150 pickup truck near the intersection of Sunol Boulevard and Arlington Drive.

The F-150 failed to yield and entered northbound Interstate 680 at the Sunol Boulevard onramp. The vehicle then exited the Stoneridge Drive exit and reentered northbound Interstate 680 traveling southbound against the flow of traffic. Officers immediately terminated the pursuit, and under safe conditions, they entered southbound Interstate 680 and located the vehicle, which was abandoned one mile south of where it entered the freeway. The Pleasanton Police Department's K-9 unit searched the area and apprehended a suspect identified as Calvin Fries. A second search was coordinated with the Alameda County Sheriff's Office and no additional suspects were located. At this time, the investigation is ongoing.

Unrelated to the investigation, a vehicle traveling northbound on Interstate 680 struck the abandoned F-150. No injuries resulted from the collision.
