### Vehicle Struck Moving Train

On Monday, June 14, 2021, at 3:00 pm, the Pleasanton Police Department received a call stating a vehicle was struck by a Union Pacific Train on St. Mary Street. Officers responded to the area and located one vehicle with significant front-end damage. The occupants of the car were not injured. It appears the railroad crossing signal was working correctly.

The train blocked the St. Mary Street and the Santa Rita Road railroad crossings for approximately two hours. Union Pacific Railroad sent two rail inspectors who determined the tracks were not damaged. The vehicle was towed from the scene, and the Pleasanton PD is still investigating the cause of the collision.
