### Pleasanton Police Department's Teen Academy Returns for 2021

The Pleasanton Police Department is accepting applications from Pleasanton youth for its Teen Academy, a three-week program beginning July 6th.

The goal of the Teen Academy is to develop stronger partnerships between the Pleasanton Police Department and youth it serves. Participants will have a unique opportunity to learn about law enforcement procedures from our officers, including such topics as patrol procedures, dispatch communications, SWAT, investigations, juvenile traffic issues, K-9, evidence collection and animal services. The Academy is offered free of charge to local high school students, between the ages of 14 and 18. This program consists of nine classes that are three hours each. Most classes are held from 2:00 p.m. until 5:00 p.m. with exceptions for graduation and a tour of Santa Rita Jail. Classes will be held on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays on the following dates: July 6, 7, 8, 13, 14, 15, 20, 21, and will conclude with a graduation dinner on Thursday, July 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2021.
