Audiences can swing and sway to the music of Natalie Cole, Nat King Cole and songs from the Great American Songbook on Saturday, September 25, at 8:00pm.

With Jackie’s velvety voice featured alongside her electrifying band, this group brings the same joy and excitement as witnessing Natalie Cole live on tour. Featuring popular songs like “This Will Be”, “The Very Thought of You”, “Smile”, and the anthemic “Unforgettable”, Jackie takes listeners on a magical, musical ride through the different decades of each artist’s career, sharing tales of love, life, heartache, and happiness along the way.

A native of San Jose, Jackie grew up surrounded by a diverse music community. And it was the stylings of the popular Jazz and R&B singers, such as Dionne Warwick, Ella Fitzgerald, and Natalie Cole from her childhood that would go on to have a major influence on her career.
