PLEASANTON POLICE LAUNCHES SURVEILLANCE CAMERA REGISTRY

To help deter criminals and keep our city safe, the Pleasanton Police Department is asking residents and businesses to register their surveillance cameras.

“This is a valuable tool for our community to use,” said Sergeant Robert Shuffield, “and will significantly benefit our investigative efforts. Time and again, thanks to our community’s assistance, surveillance video has provided our detectives with clues they need to crack the case.”

Knowing where security cameras are installed around Pleasanton can help us solve cases and lead to the conviction of suspects who are caught on video. This surveillance camera registry system is voluntary. By registering your surveillance camera(s), your information will be shared only with law enforcement personnel and does not permit the Pleasanton Police Department direct access or use of your surveillance system. If a crime occurs in your neighborhood, your surveillance video could be the vital piece of evidence in an investigation. If your system is registered with us, Pleasanton Police Department detectives may ask you to share relevant surveillance video from a particular date and time.
