### POLICE REQUESTS PUBLIC'S HELP DURING INVESTIGATION INTO ATTEMPTED AUTO THEFT THAT RESULTED IN GUNFIRE

Pleasanton Police Department is currently investigating an attempted auto theft that resulted in gunfire and asks anyone who may have witnessed or has information about this incident to call (925) 931-5100.

On June 28, 2022, at approximately 4:50 a.m., the Pleasanton Police Department received multiple reports of gunshots in the parking lot of Canyon Meadows neighborhood. When officers arrived on scene, they learned a victim had confronted two suspects inside and around his vehicle. The victim was pepper sprayed by a suspect and heard a shot fired towards him. The victim, who was legally in possession of a firearm and able to carry, fired multiple rounds towards the suspects. Two vehicles in the parking lot were struck by bullets. The suspects fled in a pickup truck out of the complex in an unknown direction. At this time, we have not received reports of any injuries related to this incident. Pleasanton detectives are on scene and the investigation is ongoing.
