The Position:

Under general direction of a Captain, the Fire Engineer performs all the duties of a Firefighter and is responsible for the day-to-day operation of assigned apparatus and equipment. The Fire Engineer maintains, drives, and operates apparatus and equipment in a safe and professional manner. The Engineer may assume the responsibilities of a Captain when assigned and other duties as required.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

Training/Education:

- Must meet standards for Firefighter/EMT
- Successful completion of either California State Fire Marshal Driver/Operator 1A and 1B or the LPFD Driver Operator course are required
- LPFD Aerial Certification is required at time of appointment
- Successful completion of the State of California Fire Officer Certification program is preferred

Experience:

- Three (3) years service as a paid member of the LPFD

License/Certification:

- Valid California Driver's License
- When required, a valid Medical Examiner's Card must be maintained
- Current state of California EMT (with required endorsements)
- Firefighter I certification or completion of approved certification requirements

To be considered for this position, submit a completed employment application by 17:00 hours, February 24, 2014 . Selection Process:

Upon review of the applications, candidates meeting the minimum qualifications will be invited to a **written examination the week of March 10, 2014**. Upon successful completion of the written exam, candidates will be scheduled for manipulative events, which may include, but not limited to: drafting problems and knowledge, pumping from tank or hydrant, a driving course, a skills vehicle rodeo, and/or a pre-trip inspection. The dates for these **manipulative events will be the week of March 31, 2014**. An eligibility list will be prepared based on the process results of each applicant.

It is the responsibility of the applicant to follow the directions for completion of the application. Failure to do so may result in disqualification.
