- ☺ Participants requiring personal care assistance such as toileting, eating, or special medical attention must attend with a care provider.



1. Pre-registration is required for all activities. Limited spaces are available.
2. Resident mail-in registration will be processed in random order beginning August 6th. Non-resident registration will be processed in random order beginning August 13th, 2014.
3. A participant profile **MUST** be filled out in its entirety before the individual will be registered. Please call 931-5365 if you need a copy.
4. A registration form with release waiver must be signed by participants and/or legal guardian prior to participation in any activity.
5. If an activity is full, participants will be placed on a waiting list. If a space becomes available, the participant will be contacted by phone. Payment must be made prior to the day of the event.
