

Youth Sports Official – Basketball (part-time, temporary)

The Youth and Adult Sports program seeks several part-time Recreation Leader IIIs to work as youth sports officials/scorekeepers at the Harvest Park, Hart, and Pleasanton Middle School gymnasiums.

The Position: Under direction of the Recreation Supervisor, Youth Sports Officials will officiate and scorekeep selected basketball games in the Pleasanton Youth Basketball (PYB) program. Participants range from grades 1-12.

PYB games are held on Saturdays from December 6, 2014 to February 28, 2015. Youth Sports Officials work 5-12 hours per week, with assignments anytime between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 9:00 p.m. on weekends and 5-9 p.m. on weekday evenings.

These are part-time, temporary positions. Employees may not work more than 960 hours per fiscal year. They do not offer benefits, but do contribute to Apple and Medicare. CPR and First Aid certification may be required. The City will provide training and certification classes, as required.


Typical Duties

- Set up program equipment and prepare gymnasium for games.
- Officiate and scorekeep youth basketball games.
- Assist gym monitors with enforcing gym rules and regulations.

The ideal candidate will:

- Have excellent customer service skills and experience with basketball officiating.
- Possess knowledge of basketball rules and regulations.
- Write legibly.
- Be able to lift 25 pounds of program equipment.
- Under limited supervision, work with youth basketball players and coaches in a positive and effective manner.
- Be able to enthusiastically interact with spectators and permits..

The Selection Process: The Recreation Supervisor will review applications as they are received. The most qualified applicants will be invited for an interview. Reference checks will be conducted prior to making an offer. Prior to starting employment, the selected applicant must provide a certification showing that he/she has undergone and successfully cleared a tuberculosis test within the past two years, or undergo a tuberculosis test arranged by the City. Applicants



selected for the positions will also be required to undergo and successfully complete a fingerprint background check by the City prior to starting employment. Applicants under age 18 must provide a copy of a valid work permit prior to starting employment.
