ALTAMONT EDUCATION ADVISORY BOARD

The City of Pleasanton is recruiting a member to participate on the Altamont Education Advisory Board. The representative must be a Science, Environmental Education or Vocational Education teacher from the Pleasanton Public Schools.

ALTAMONT COMMUNITY MONITOR COMMITTEE

This committee oversees the services of the Community Monitor of the Altamont Landfill and Resource Recovery Facility.

ALAMEDA COUNTY PARATRANSIT ADVISORY AND PLANNING COMMITTEE (PAPCO)

PAPCO members advise Alameda CTC on the development and implementation of paratransit programs, including a grant program. All members must be Alameda County residents who use transportation that supports seniors and people with disabilities.
