



#### ONE Pleasanton – Strategic Plan Priorities



- **1. Funding Our Future Strategy 1.** Funding operations and maintenance needs of community-owned facilities and infrastructure

- **3. Investing in Our Environment Strategy 3.** *Implement the Water Supply Alternative Study recommendations to resolve PFAS water quality issues*
- **4. Safeguarding Our City Strategy 1.** Assess the City's overall emergency preparedness and implement changes as needed

# Emergency Management Priorities - 2025

- Updated the Emergency Operations Plan
- Finalized the Injury and Illness Prevention Program (IIPP) update
- Relocated City's Emergency Operations Center in May 2025







#### Emergency Management Priorities - 2025 Cont.

- Delivered Disaster Academy Program to 196
  City Staff members
- Conducted a Fire Season functional exercise in May 2025 based on the 2022 Canyon Fire incident.
- Completed evacuation drills at Civic Center and Operations Service Center campuses in April.

- Continuing work on the Crisis Communications and Alert & Warning Plans
- Updating Power Outage Guidelines
- Developing a Business Emergency Preparedness project
- Planning Wet Season Functional Exercise in November
