Subject: Alameda County Fairgrounds Land Use Agreement

This memorandum provides an overview of the existing agreement between the City and Alameda County regarding land use at the Fairgrounds. The scope of the agreement addresses uses at the Fairgrounds, including short-term and special events, as well as longer-term and permanent uses of the property.

The memo also provides information about noise regulations for the Fairgrounds with respect to City noise standards.

Fairgrounds Ownership and Governance

The Fairgrounds property and its facilities are owned by Alameda County and operated by the Alameda County Agricultural Fair Association (Fair Association), a 501(c)(3) non-profit that is considered an Agent of the County. The Fair Association in turn is governed by a 19-member Board with a CEO and professional staff who manage day-to-day operations of the facility.

1997 Fairgrounds Land Use Agreement

The current Land Use Agreement (Agreement) was approved by the City and Alameda County in September 1997 (Attachment 1). The terms of the Agreement reflect the unique circumstance of Alameda County's ownership of the property within the Pleasanton City limits, and the long-standing, historic presence of the Fairgrounds within Pleasanton, distinguishing and assigning different review and approval authority to the County and the City based on three land use categories:

- A. Historical Uses of the Fairgrounds
- B. New Public Uses on the Fairgrounds
- C. Private Uses on the Fairgrounds

A. Historical Uses of the Fairground

Under the Agreement, "Historical uses" are those that are consistent with the use of the Fairgrounds and which have historically taken place at the Fairgrounds or that further the

purposes of the Fair Association and the County Fair.” As an Agent of Alameda County, the Fair Association is assigned the authority to review/approve these historic uses, which generally encompass activities occurring within existing facilities, special events (including the County Fair), and routine supportive operations and functions of the Fairgrounds.

Among the uses considered “historic” are:

- The annual County Fair, and ancillary events held during the Fair, such as horse racing and the carnival/midway
- Stables/horse racing training facilities
- Parimutuel wagering facility (Also known as the “Off-Track Betting” facility)
- Outdoor Amphitheater
- Exhibition halls and outdoor space used for temporary fairs and events
- Operation of existing indoor and outdoor facilities such as picnic areas, meeting rooms, museum, and maintenance facilities
- Special Events, a sample list of which is included as an attachment to the Agreement.

B. New Public Uses

New or expanded public facilities or activities on the Fairgrounds—such as new exhibition halls, County government offices, transit stations, or public parks—are reviewed primarily by the County.

For such uses, the County is the reviewing/approving authority and acts as the lead agency for CEQA environmental review.

With respect to the scope of City review:

- The City receives formal notice and may provide recommendations on such uses
- The City Planning Commission reviews proposed public uses for General Plan consistency, but the County is not required to follow City recommendations, nor would a City finding of General Plan inconsistency be a basis for County denial of a land use application.

C. Private Uses

When the County leases Fairgrounds property, long-term, to private entities for private use or benefit, the City has full zoning and permitting authority, including application of City Zoning standards, determination of General Plan compliance, and acting as the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) lead agency. Existing private uses are allowed to continue if they are operated consistently with past operations.

Examples of uses that have been treated as new “private” uses, and subject to City approvals, include wireless facilities, the recently installed Ballistic United Futsal facility, and an expansion of buildings at the golf course.

The Agreement assigns authority for review and issuance of Building Permits for new Private Uses to the City, but in practice, this function is usually undertaken by Alameda County.

Permitting Requirements and Implementation

Under the Agreement, Category A and B uses are not subject to any City permitting, zoning, or regulatory requirements, except that Public Uses are subject to payment of City Sales Tax and Business License fees similar to other private businesses in Pleasanton. For example, sales taxes generated during the County Fair or during special events are paid to the City.

Private uses are subject to City approval, and to City zoning requirements, permitting, licensing, and fees.

Today, and on a practical level, implementation of the agreement generally occurs in alignment with its terms. The City, County, and Fairgrounds are, in most cases, able to resolve questions about how uses are to be classified, and where a project would have a potential off-site impact or affect City facilities, the County, and the Fairgrounds have been amenable to including City recommendations in those projects.

However, there is room for improved clarity in some areas of the agreement, such as the list of “historic uses” (which is incomplete and dated), as well as better alignment with actual practices.

Operational Issues / Noise

Noise is a frequently cited concern in conjunction with events at the Fairgrounds. As noted, the City has limited authority over “Historic” Land Uses, including the special events permitted by the Fairgrounds over the course of the year.

The City’s Noise Ordinance (PMC Chapter 9.04) includes a specific exemption for noise associated with approved special events at the Fairgrounds (and on other public property such as City parks and at schools), as follows:

9.04.060.D. Special Events. Any community activity, sporting event, or special event occurring at the Alameda County fairgrounds, upon any public school grounds, or at any city parks or streets is exempt from the provisions of this chapter, provided that the event has been approved by the appropriate fair association official, school official or city department or city council.

Instead, the Fairgrounds relies on its agreements with special events operators (these agreements include some limits/standards around amplified noise), a community notification process, and coordination with the Pleasanton Police Department, to provide notice of larger or noisier events. In recent months, the City has been receiving a larger volume of complaints and concerns about noise from Fairgrounds events. Given these concerns, the City has reached out to Fairgrounds staff to discuss ways to address the issues, whether through improved notification procedures or better internal controls on the types of events and activities permitted by the Fair Authority.

Conclusion

The existing Land Use Agreement has been in place for almost 30 years and recognizes the unique and valuable role the Fairgrounds play in Pleasanton. While the Agreement has worked relatively well over time in regulating operations at the Fairgrounds and providing the City with a reasonable degree of oversight of new uses, there are areas in which the Agreement could benefit from greater clarity - e.g. in defining the parameters of allowable special events, improving the list of “historic uses”, and better aligning the agreement with actual practices.

Staff will be re-engaging with the Fairgrounds around noise and other off-site impacts from special events to discuss better controls and oversight for events that have the potential to generate high noise levels, with the goal of improving City and community awareness and communications around noisy and disruptive special events.

**LAND USE AGREEMENT FOR THE
ALAMEDA COUNTY FAIRGROUNDS**

County of Alameda and City of Pleasanton
September 10, 1997

The County of Alameda is the owner of the Alameda County Fairgrounds (Fairgrounds), which is located in the City of Pleasanton, and the facilities thereon, and the Alameda County Agricultural Fair Association (Fair Association) acts as the County's agent to hold and conduct the annual Alameda County Fairs and other interim event activities.

The Fairground has been developed to accommodate use of the site for the annual fairs and other interim event activities.

The following is an agreement between the City of Pleasanton (City) and the County of Alameda (County) regarding land use protocols relating to the Fairgrounds.

A. Historical Uses of Fairgrounds

The County shall continue to review and act on land uses which are consistent with the use of the Fairgrounds and facilities and which have historically taken place at the Fairgrounds or that further the purposes of the Fair Association and the County Fair.

1. These include, but are not limited to, the following:
 - a. Alameda County Fair, including the ancillary horse racing during the Fair and the carnival/midway.
 - b. Parimutuel wagering satellite facility.
 - c. Stables/horse racing training facility.
 - d. Ancillary fair and training temporary residences.
 - e. Picnic and barbecue facilities.
 - f. Banquet facilities.
 - g. Outdoor amphitheater and grandstands.
 - h. Exhibition halls and outdoor space, used for temporary fairs, expositions, and exhibitions.
 - i. Meeting rooms and facilities.

j. Museum facilities.

k. Ancillary administrative, custodial, and maintenance facilities.

Examples of these uses are further identified in the "tentative 1996 Interim Events," attached as Exhibit A.

2. These historical land uses include those activities that the Fair Association, as an agent of the County and dealing with County property, is entitled to permit or perform consistent with the County's powers as a subdivision of the State and, in general, to use the Fairgrounds to further the purposes of the Fair Association and the County Fair.
3. These historical land uses include activities which may be franchised to or operated by private, independent for-profit or non-profit entities so long as they are consistent with the historical use of the property as a Fairgrounds, use Fairgrounds facilities or are of a temporary nature (e.g., exhibitions, shows, games).
4. To be considered a historical land use under this section, a use must be operated consistent with the hours of operation, capacities of facilities, including on-site parking sufficient for the use, and operational characteristics of historically similar uses.
5. Procedurally, uses under this section shall be reviewed and approved by the County, acting independently or through its agent, the Fair Association, in a manner consistent with the County processes and regulations. County will keep City apprised of Fairgrounds projects by certified mail with return receipt and will consider recommendations from Pleasanton in its actions.
6. Notwithstanding the above, the City reserves the right to contest on a case by case basis the County's or the Fair Association's determination that a particular use/activity is a historical use/activity.

B. New Public Uses on the Fairgrounds

The county shall review and act on new public land uses on the Fairgrounds.

1. New public land uses for the purpose of this section consist of expansions of, or additions to, the existing facilities of the Fairgrounds for County Fair purposes and construction of new facilities to serve a public purpose. Examples include, but are not limited to, constructing new or expanding existing exhibition halls, constructing County government offices, and using the Fairgrounds for a publicly operated park and ride lots, train station and/or other quasi-governmental purposes.

2. *Procedurally, the County shall follow its established procedures and the requirements of Government Code §65402 in reviewing these new public land uses. For projects initiated by the Fair Association, the Fair Association shall submit all proposed projects to the County Community Development Agency (CDA) for review under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). The CDA will notify City by certified mail with return receipt.*
 - a. For projects at the Fairgrounds subject to this section which may be subject to CEQA, the County shall be the lead agency for purposes of CEQA. The CDA will prepare the environmental assessment and any environmental documentation as may be required by law, and it will ensure that the requirements of CEQA are met. The City shall be notified as an interested party for all CEQA-related actions -- exemptions, Negative Declarations, and Environmental Impact Reports. The County shall involve the City in CEQA-related matters at the earliest stage of project.
 - b. The locations, purpose, and extent of any such new public land use shall be submitted to the City Planning Commission for its report as to conformity with its general plan at least forty days prior to anticipated action on the new public land use.
 - c. The City Planning Commission shall report to the County within 40 days as to the conformity of the new public land use to the City's General Plan or part thereof. Failure to report shall be deemed a finding of consistency.
 - d. The City shall further make a recommendation to the County, should it choose to do so, concerning the merits of the use, including conditions which may be attached to it.
 - e. The County shall consider City's recommendations but neither a determination of inconsistency with the City's general Plan nor recommendation for denial of the use shall require the County's disapproval.
3. Notwithstanding the above, the City reserves the right to contest on a case by case basis the County's or the Fair Association's determination that a new use is a public land use.

C. Private Uses on the Fairgrounds

The County shall submit to the zoning jurisdiction of the City for new or expanded private land uses on the Fairgrounds, and the City shall review and act on such uses.

1. Private land uses are those wherein the County or Fair Association is selling or

leasing land and/or facilities on a long-term basis to a private entity and where the private development is for the private purposes of the private entity. That the County or Fair Association may receive revenues to support its other activities is not determinative whether the use is public or private.

2. Procedurally, these uses shall follow the development procedures, processes, and requirements of the City, including; its General Plan, zoning ordinance, and related ordinances. The County Community Development Agency (CDA) will prepare and submit an application, including initial CEQA documentation, to the city for its review and action. The City shall be the lead agency for purposes of CEQA; the County shall be a responsible agency.
3. Existing private uses shall be allowed to continue so long as they are operated in a manner consistent with their historical uses. Modifications and/or expansions/additions to these uses shall be subject to the City review procedure described in Section C(2) above.

D. Permit Process and Regulations

Public uses of County Facilities described in Sections A and B of this Agreement are exempt from the City permit process. This exemption applies to the City zoning regulations, public health and safety regulations, building codes, licensing requirements, and other such requirements imposed by the City on private businesses within its limits, except that such public uses may be subject to payment of sales taxes and business license fees as may be applicable in the City. Private uses as described in Section C must meet all City permit/licensing/fee requirements.

1. Notwithstanding the division of authority over public health and safety matters at the Fairgrounds, the parties recognize the historic cooperation which has occurred between the agencies in providing public health and safety services to the Fairgrounds. The parties wish to ensure that proper safety-related measures are required and enforced in as efficient manner as feasible, giving due deference to the governmental prerogatives of each agency.
 - a. All uses, structures, and activities shall meet the public health and safety codes effective within the jurisdiction responsible for the use, structures or activities; County shall be the responsible jurisdiction for public uses and City shall be the responsible jurisdiction for private uses. The responsible authority shall use its best efforts, including periodic inspections and monitoring, to ensure health and safety codes are enforced.
 - b. The County may choose to have City codes/ inspections applied to any new construction, alternation, repair, maintenance, or use, subject to meeting City requirements for plan review submittals, fees, etc. The County shall give the City notice of any such role it wishes to delegate to the City with sufficient time for the City to exercise its authority in a manner similar to

that accorded other such permit/ inspections in the City. The City is not obligated to undertake the requested service delegation, but it shall exercise its best efforts to do so when requested.

2. In implementing subsection D(1)(b) above, the agencies' staffs may by memorandum establish procedures for certain permits/inspections based on the classification of event, type of permit, etc. Such a memorandum shall constitute a proper delegation under this agreement.

E. Dispute Resolution

The City and County shall make good faith attempts to resolve disputes involving categorization of uses between Sections A, B, and C of this Agreement.

F. Superior Rights

This Agreement is not intended to limit or change each other's rights as provided under State law, including the City's right to contest that a particular use or activity on Fairgrounds property is not exempt from City ordinances, rules and regulations.
