## ALAMEDA COUNTY DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S OFFICE ISSUES REPORT REGARDING OFFICER-INVOLVED SHOOTING

The Alameda County District Attorney's Office issued its report on the February 17, 2022 officer-involved shooting in Pleasanton, California. After careful review, the District Attorney's Office concluded the officers' use of deadly force was necessary in the defense of others and the involved officers will not be charged with a crime.

It is standard procedure for any officer-involved shooting incident in Alameda County to be independently investigated by the Alameda County District Attorney's Office and their Officer-Involved Shooting (OIS) Team. Following a 10-month investigation, the OIS team, which consists of experienced inspectors and deputy district attorneys determined:

All available evidence indicated the involved officers were justified in believing Cody Chavez posed a significant threat of death or serious bodily injury to others ... there is insufficient evidence to support the criminal prosecution of the involved officers. (District Attorney's Report, p. 18)
