### Why License?

- Identification on your dog's collar can save your pet's life should your pet become lost or injured.
- Licensing verifies your dog has a current rabies vaccination. This is important if your dog is involved in a bite or has contact with a wild animal.
- Avoid citations that start at \$100 per unlicensed dog.
- Licensing is required by law!

# Dog License Application



# Pleasanton Municipal Code <u>Dog Licensing:</u>

### 7.12.010 Required.

Any resident of the city who is an owner of a dog over four month of age shall have a current dog license tag for the dog.

### 7.12.050 Anti-rabies Vaccination Required.

As a condition for the issuance of a license, all applicants for such license shall procure and deliver to the licensing authority a certificate issued by a duly licensed veterinarian certifying that the dog to be licensed has been administered an anti-rabies vaccination within 30 days prior to the issuance of said license, or has received anti-rabies vaccination sufficient to immunize said dog against rabies for the current license period.

### Licensing Terms Available:

You may license your dog for one, two, or three years <u>based on the date your dog's</u> rabies vaccination expires.

**Note**: You may only license for the period remaining on the dog's rabies vaccination. (Fees are based on one year increments - no partial years).

### Dog License Fees:

Your dog's license fee is determined by the term of the license you choose, and whether or not your dog is spayed or neutered. If your dog is a <u>spayed</u> female or a <u>neutered</u> male, the licensing fee is reduced. **See table** - above right.

### Dog License Fees:
