

# Joint Groundwater Wells Study

*Providing safe and reliable water in Pleasanton, today and tomorrow*

## PROJECT OVERVIEW

The City of Pleasanton and Zone 7 Water Agency are partnering on a study to assess the feasibility of building new groundwater wells in Pleasanton.

## SECURING PLEASANTON'S WATER FUTURE

Pleasanton's groundwater wells are offline due to PFAS concentrations, and new wells will restore a reliable, safe local water supply. By partnering with Zone 7, the City will share costs and have first priority to 3,500 acre-feet of water from the new wells.

## BENEFITS OF THESE LOCATIONS

- City-owned property, simplifying implementation
- Close to Zone 7's Hopyard Treatment Facility for cost-effective, reliable treatment
- Ample space for construction and operation
- Outside the assumed PFAS footprint, pending study confirmation

## ANTICIPATED PROJECT TIMELINE



**FALL 2024**

Phase I begins: Test Well Drilling & Feasibility Study.



**SUMMER 2025**

Feasibility Study completed.



**FALL 2025**

Phase II: Design & Construction begins.  
*(pending feasibility study results)*



**SPRING 2029**

New wells operational.
