

**City of Pleasanton Water-Efficient Irrigation Rebate Program
For Irrigation Customers**

Terms and Conditions

Program Effective January 1, 2012 (Revised January 2025)

**FUNDING IS LIMITED AND ON A FIRST-COME, FIRST-SERVED BASIS!
Maximum rebate \$200 per site**

Program Overview:

The City of Pleasanton's Water-Efficient Irrigation Rebate Program (WEIR) program is designed to reduce outdoor water use for irrigation customers through the installation of water-efficient irrigation hardware in areas supplying irrigation to functional turf.

This rebate is to be used in conjunction with the following rebate programs to maximize water savings:

Zone 7's Weather-Based Irrigation Controller Rebate:

Zone 7's Water-Efficient Lawn Conversion Rebate:

City of Pleasanton's Eco-Friendly Lawn Conversion Rebate:

By participating in this rebate program, you agree to the following Terms and Conditions. These terms outline the guidelines for program eligibility and receiving your rebate. Please read through the following terms carefully before participating in the program. Program Eligibility and Requirements:

To qualify for this rebate, applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Applicants must have a dedicated irrigation meter.
- Applicants must have an active water account(s) in good standing within the City of Pleasanton.
- Installed irrigation hardware for rebate consideration must only be installed and used on "functional" turf areas as defined in Assembly Bill 1572, Non-Functional Turf Ban.
- **Customers must be participating in or have participated in the past, in Zone 7's Water-Efficient Landscape Rebate program and/or the City's Eco-Friendly Lawn Conversion Rebate Program.**
- The site must currently have a weather-based irrigation controller or be in the process of applying for a weather-based irrigation controller through Zone 7.
- Applicants must install the approved hardware per manufacturer's directions **within 60 days of purchase date.**
- The site must have water use history (past 3 years).
- The site must have a well-maintained irrigation system that is in good working order.
- Applicants must install specified water-efficient hardware per manufacturer's directions.

- Installation must be complete before the issuance of the rebate
- Hardware must remain installed for a minimum of two (2) years.
- Applicants must agree to a pre-and-post inspection.

Qualifying Equipment and Rebate Amounts:

- Funding is limited and on a first-come, first-served basis.
- Maximum rebate of \$200 per site.
- Rebate is issued as water bill credit or by check.
- Sales tax, installation, programming costs, and any other fees are not rebated

Qualifying Irrigation Equipment and Rebate Amounts	
Rain Sensor	Up to \$50 per sensor
Pressure Regulating Devices servicing converted area	Up to 25%
Water-Efficient Rotary Nozzles (with pressure regulation and/or check valves)	
Flow sensor or Hydrometer
