Preschool Class Descriptions

<u>2's Class</u>

The 2's classes are designed to provide a warm supportive environment for your child's first independent classroom experience. Children are encouraged to explore, create, and learn. Diapering is offered by our amazing staff as your child prepares for potty independence. We inspire our 2's to discover new abilities in art, music, literature, and language development through PLAY!

<u>3's Class</u>

The 3's classes provide a learning environment designed to promote your child's growth and development while we learn through play! Areas of focus include numbers and 1:1 correspondence, nursery rhymes, colors, shapes, literature, fine and large motor skill development, and social emotional learning.

<u>3's & 4's Class</u>

In this blended class, our teachers provide a dual age level curriculum allowing children to receive materials and instruction to meet their developmental needs. As with all classes, children are encouraged to work and play at their own pace as teachers work on individual learning goals. Please review information on 3's and 4's class for more detailed focus areas.

<u>4's Class</u>

The 4's classes encourage preschoolers' natural curiosity to learn with a strong developmentally appropriate curriculum. The program builds confidence and promotes resilience and kindergarten readiness. Areas of focus include language skills, Handwriting Without Tears curriculum, numbers 1-100 and 1:1 correspondence, literature and daily reading, fine and large motor development, fostering creativity, and social emotional development.

Enrichment Class Descriptions

My Grown Up & Me

This class provides a fun classroom experience designed to encourage multi-sensory experiences to stimulate language, socialization, creativity, and independence in your child. Parent and child attend class together.

STEAM Fridays

This enrichment class opens a wonderful world of opportunities for young children. Children will engage in handson, minds-on activities that will develop curious lifelong learners. Children will problem solve, create, investigate, and play.
