### **Weapon Brandishing / Criminal Threats Arrest**

On April 22, 2015 at 1:13 pm Pleasanton Police responded to a residence on Foothill Road in the vicinity of Lydicksen School. The parents of an adult male reported their son brandished a knife and threatened to kill them. The suspect fled as officers were enroute. Due to safety concerns and the unknown whereabouts of the suspect, Lydicksen Elementary School on Highland Oaks Drive was placed on "Locked Down." This was precautionary and at no time was there an indication the suspect was an immediate threat or danger to the staff or children.

At about 1:45 pm the suspect, 27 year old Christopher Kliment, was located at the West Pleasanton BART station awaiting a train and was detained without incident. The weapon used in the brandishing was recovered at the residence. Kliment was subsequently booked in Santa Rita Jail for brandishing a weapon and making criminal threats.

Pleasanton Unified School District officials were notified to lift the "Lock Down" at 2:00 pm.
