Hit and Run Suspect Arrested

On January 14, 2016 at approximately 11:14 pm, a citizen witnessed a white Toyota pickup, traveling northbound on First Street; collide into the rear of a vehicle parked just north of Neal Street. The citizen immediately called the police and reported that the driver exited the vehicle and fled on foot toward Second Street. Officers surrounded the area and within minutes observed an individual, later identified as 22-year-old Erick Tornero from Livermore, on Kottinger between First Street and Second Street matching the suspect description bleeding from his forehead. As officers attempted to stop and detain Tornero, he fled eastbound Kottinger on foot. Tornero began hopping fences and a perimeter was established. Tornero was located in the rear yard of a residence in the 4100 block of Vineyard Avenue.

The Pleasanton Police Department relies on its partnership with their residents to keep this community safe and reminds citizens to immediately call the police and report suspicious behavior.
