### **All- Abilities Playground RFQ**

1. We are interested to learn more about the conflicting uses of the site. If possible, could you please elaborate on what the known conflicts are?
  - a. Ken Mercer Sports Park is a heavily utilized park throughout the year. We strongly desire an all-abilities playground design that meets the needs of the whole child/participant which includes considering their motor and sensory needs. Conflicting uses at the park would be considered as the following:
    - Proximity of the playground to the softball fields and the noise level of the games and potential for errant balls to land in the playground
    - Other games or events with large attendance that could heavily utilize parking
    - Excessive number of participants in the park that could increase the noise level
