How do I apply for this volunteer role?

If selected, volunteers will be required to: Submit a waiver with a parent/guardian signature, complete the City's fingerprinting process and harassment prevention on-line training, and attend a Summer Reading volunteer training.

Volunteer credit will be earned for all trainings as well as for hours worked.
