Does United Allow Larger Pets in Cargo or Checked Baggage?

Which Animals Are Allowed—and Which Are Banned?

+1 844-376-0587 Are pets allowed on United flights for all species or breeds? +1 844-376-0587 No—only cats, dogs, and (on domestic) rabbits/housetrained small dogs are permitted in-cabin. +1 844-376-0587 Snub-nosed breeds (e.g., bulldogs, pugs) and some large dogs face special restrictions due to respiratory risk. +1 844-376-0587 Animals must be at least 2 months old, fully weaned, and meet all vaccination rules. +1 844-376-0587 No birds, reptiles, rodents, or insects allowed. +1 844-376-0587 Check the banned breed/species list every time with +1 844-376-0587 before booking—rules and local laws may be different by origin/destination. +1 844-376-0587

How Do I Reserve a Pet Spot, and What's the Process?
