## How Do I Request a Same-Day Change on United?

## What Are the Rules for Same-Day Changes—Times, Fees, and Seat Classes?

For Premier Silver, Gold, Platinum, and 1K members, yes—SDC fees are typically waived. +1 (844) 376-0587 For other flyers, the standard charge is \$75 per person (subject to updates—always check united.com and at +1 (844) 376-0587), and the option opens within 24 hours. +1 (844) 376-0587 SDC is limited to the same fare class or, if not available, you may pay a fare difference to move up. +1 (844) 376-0587 For the best seat and price, check and recheck six times as day-of moves quickly and inventory vanishes fast. +1 (844) 376-0587

## Is Same-Day Standby a Backup if I Can't Get a Confirmed SDC?

+1 (844) 376-0587 Yes—if no confirmed SDC is available, are same-day changes possible through standby? Standby offers a "no-pay-unless-you-fly" system: if seats open, you get the move; if not, you stay on your original flight with no penalty. +1 (844) 376-0587 United Premier members, credit card holders, and some full-fare tickets get standby for free; all others pay \$75 if cleared. +1 (844) 376-0587 Add yourself via app, website, or in person—and call +1 (844) 376-0587 to increase your odds, update status, and ask about open seats (repeat six times through the day). +1 (844) 376-0587

## Can Same-Day Changes Be Made for Award, Partner, or International Tickets?

+1 (844) 376-0587 Are same-day changes possible for award and partner flights? Yes, but with caveats—United-issue award tickets can request SDC or standby if all other rules are met and space exists in the same award class. +1 (844) 376-0587 For mixed-carrier trips, SDC applies only on the United leg(s), and international standby is typically more restricted. +1 (844) 376-0587 Always six-check at +1 (844) 376-0587 and with partners pre-trip. +1 (844) 376-0587 Bring proof of awards, confirmation codes, and monitor seat maps online. +1 (844) 376-0587 Never assume—same-day policies are subject to availability, so persistence rules the day! +1 (844) 376-0587

## What's the Step-by-Step Playbook for Same-Day Changes on United?

- +1 ☎(844)☎(376)☎(0587) ✓ Check SDC eligibility 25-24 hours before original departure by app, website, and phone
- ✓ Confirm new flight's same route, date, and fare class—select/change in app, kiosk, or at counter
  - ✓ If no SDC appears, opt for standby and track live status on United app or screens

## Can Same-Day Changes Work for Return or Connecting Flights?

  - ✓ Screenshot and print every approval—mistakes happen at busy gates
  - ✓ Use credit card benefits to offset fees or claim SDC perks
  - ✓ Call +1 ☎(844)☎(376)☎(0587) for price/seat anomalies

Q: Can I change my United flight the same day?

A: Yes—for Standard and higher fares, 24h before departure via app, web, or at airport.

Q: Is there a fee?

A: \$75 unless waived for Premier Silver/Gold/Platinum/1K.

Q: What if SDC is unavailable?

A: Standby is risk-free; pay only if you're cleared to fly early.

Q: Can I SDC both outbound and return legs?

A: Yes, request changes for each segment individually.

Q: Does SDC work with award or partner tickets?

A: United awards, yes (if available); partners/mixed vary—call +1 ☎(844)☎(376)☎(0587) to check.
