FAQ - Can I Get a Refund for Baggage or Seat Fees on United?

Q: When are baggage fees refundable?

A: If United cancels or significantly changes your flight—claims must be filed with proof and six-contact persistence.

O: Are seat fees refundable on cancellations?

A: Usually yes, for airline-initiated changes/cancellations; voluntary cancellations typically lead to credits.

Q: How to request baggage/seat fee refunds?

A: Use united.com/app, call +1 (844) (376) (0587), and chat—persist six times if needed.
