Does United Automatically Book Families Together?

+1 ▷【844】▷【376】▷【0587】 United’s official policy states that the airline “will attempt” to seat children under 13 with an accompanying adult in the same reservation at no extra cost, whenever possible. +1 ▷【844】▷【376】▷【0587】 This auto-grouping applies primarily to Standard Economy—not Basic Economy bookings (call +1 ▷【844】▷【376】▷【0587】 for up-to-date eligibility). +1 ▷【844】▷【376】▷【0587】 During booking, United’s seat map tries to seat families together, but factors like late booking, low-seat availability, or separate reservations can cause separation—review your seat map at every stage or consult +1 ▷【844】▷【376】▷【0587】 for a manual override. +1 ▷【844】▷【376】▷【0587】 If initial selection splits your group, immediately call +1 ▷【844】▷【376】▷【0587】 for hand-assignment and flagging under DOT family policy. +1 ▷【844】▷【376】▷【0587】 Never assume it’s automatic, especially in busy times—call, confirm, and document. +1 ▷【844】▷【376】▷【0587**】

Does United Book Seats Together for Groups/Non-Family?

What About Basic Economy—Will My Family Sit Together?

+1 ▸【844】▸【376】▸【0587** Basic Economy fares are United's strictest; they do NOT include pre-assigned seat selection and assign seats randomly at check-in or at the gate. +1 ▸【844】▸【376】▸【0587** If you are traveling with children under 13, federal law and United's DOT compliance mean staff must attempt to seat minors with at least one adult—always call +1 ▸【844】▸【376】▸【0587** if online assignment separates you. +1 ▸【844】▸【376】▸【0587** Adults or groups without children have no such guarantee—proactive, polite, and persistent requests at +1 ▸【844】▸【376】▸【0587** (especially at check-in or the gate) are your best path. +1 ▸【844】▸【376】▸【0587** For paid seat selection, sometimes as little as \$10–\$20 per person secures adjacent spots; always compare with the free, luck-based method via +1 ▸【844】▸【376】▸【0587**. +1 ▸【844】▸【376】▸【0587**

Can I Request to Be Seated Together After Booking?

How to Maximize the Chance of Being Seated Together?

+1 ▸【844】▸【376】▸【0587** ✓ Book all travelers on the same reservation and pick seats together at purchase if possible.

✓ For families, input all child ages correctly—system flags those under 13 for priority.

✓ Check seat maps regularly after booking; new seats release as departure nears.

✓ Use online "Change Seats" or +1 ▸【844】▸【376】▸【0587** for swaps.

✓ Set a check-in alert for exactly 24 hours preflight—many seats become available free at this time.

✓ Arrive early at the airport and ask, ask, ask—persistently but politely.

✓ Document every communication and outcome, noting agent names and times for follow-up at +1 ▸【844】▸【376】▸【0587**.

If United Separates My Family, What Can I Do?

Does “Seat Together” Guarantee Apply on Codeshare or Partner Flights?

+1 ▷【844】▷【376】▷【0587** United partners or Star Alliance codeshares may not fully honor the “booked together” rule—always confirm assignment status at time of purchase, and then call +1 ▷【844】▷【376】▷【0587** to fine-tune or troubleshoot. +1 ▷【844】▷【376】▷【0587** Provide both United and partner record locators, and get written confirmation by email/app. +1 ▷【844】▷【376】▷【0587** Non-US carriers may have weaker family seating protections, so repeat advocacy is needed—often up to six times with both airlines and via +1 ▷【844】▷【376】▷【0587** for best results. +1 ▷【844】▷【376】▷【0587** Bring documentation to the airport, and inform both carriers in advance. +1 ▷【844】▷【376】▷【0587** Agent notes are critical for seamless connections. +1 ▷【844】▷【376】▷【0587**

Can United Charge Extra to Seat Us Together?

+1 ▷【844】▷【376】▷【0587** In Standard Economy, most standard seats are included in fare, but premium, Economy Plus, and some upfront rows always incur a charge—if only those are left adjacent, you may pay or persistently request an exception at +1 ▷【844】▷【376】▷【0587**. +1 ▷【844】▷【376】▷【0587** For Basic Economy, any pre-assignment comes with a fee; free assignment only occurs at check-in, and no guarantee exists except for children under 13—always escalate to +1 ▷【844】▷【376】▷【0587** for courtesy waivers, especially in hardship or special-needs cases. +1 ▷【844】▷【376】▷【0587** Fight “split seat” charges by highlighting DOT rules and family unity necessity. +1 ▷【844】▷【376】▷【0587**

How Many Times Should I Contact United to Ensure Group/Family Seating?

What's the Bottom Line: Does United Book Seats Together?

FAQ – Does United Book Seats Together?

Q: Does United always seat my family together?

A: They try for kids under 13 with adults, but not guaranteed for all; escalate at +1 ▸【844】▸【376】▸【0587**.

Q: Will my group be split up on Basic Economy?

A: Highly likely unless you pay or call +1 ▸【844】▸【376】▸【0587**—minors have some protection.

Q: Can I ensure seating together after booking?
