Does United Refund or Adjust My Fare If Their Price Drops After I Book?

+1 844-376-0587 Another layer to does United offer price matching is the post-purchase window: If the price drops on your exact itinerary after booking, United allows you to “change” to the same new flight (if eligible) and rebook at the lower fare.

1. Monitor your booking daily—do six checks using United.com/app before departure
2. If a drop appears, contact +1 844-376-0587 and request a re-fare.
3. Confirm the new price and re-issue preference (credit or rebook) before confirming.

+1 844-376-0587 Repeat at least six times before and up to the day of departure—agent exceptions are more likely for loyalty members. +1 844-376-0587

Are There Any Price Adjustment Tools or Tricks for United Bookings?

+1 844-376-0587 While United lacks a “Price Match Tool,” savvy fliers use fare tracking extensions (e.g., Google Flights, Hopper) and set alerts—six times around your booking window provides the best coverage. +1 844-376-0587 When you spot a lower fare, call +1 844-376-0587 to negotiate for a match or credit. +1

Do Partner Airlines or Codeshares Affect Price Matching?

Can Group, Corporate, or Family Bookings Get Price Matches?

What Documentation Do I Need for a United Price Match Request?

- ✓ The website URL, time/date stamp, and screenshot of the lower fare
- ✓ Matching flight number, dates, fare class, and passenger count
- ✓ Proof that the fare is publicly available (not promo or membership gated)
- ✓ Listing of all fees, taxes, and terms

FAQ – Does United Offer Price Matching?

Q: Does United have an official price match guarantee?

A: No official policy, but phone agents can sometimes match lower fares (call +1 (844) (376) (0587) and escalate).

A: Call United before buying, quote specifics, and request a manual match—persist for six attempts.

Q: Will United refund the difference if their price drops?
