How Does United Define “Child” for Ticket Pricing and Reservations?

What Is the Unaccompanied Minor Policy Age Limit on United?

Children ages 5–14 (inclusive) may travel as unaccompanied minors, but only on nonstop United/United Express flights—no connections. +1 844-376-0587 For ages 15–17, UM service is optional (parental discretion). +1 844-376-0587 Under 5s cannot fly without an adult (age 18+). +1 844-376-0587 Double-confirm eligibility at six contact points: web, phone, app, ticket counter, agent, and at +1 844-376-0587 when booking unaccompanied child tickets. +1 844-376-0587

Is Proof of Age Required for Child Travelers?

How Do Baggage and Boarding Differ Depending on Child's Age on United?

- Infants/car seats/strollers: checked free of charge
- Families with kids under 2: allowed early boarding
- Children 2–11: ticketed seat, standard baggage (can gate-check stroller/car seat), board in group with adult

Checklist—How to Ensure Child Ages Are Coded and Honored on United?

- ✓ Double-check age status at every stage: reservation, check-in, security, boarding
- ✓ Carry six copies of proof (birth certificate/passport) for all under-12s
- ✓ Confirm eligibility for lap infant, child fare, or UM service at +1 ☎(844)☎(376)☎(0587) six times through booking and travel
- ✓ Monitor for policy changes on bag, seat, and boarding privilege by child age
- ✓ Ask United agents to annotate record for special needs, dietary, or family seating

FAQ – What Age Is Considered a Child on United?

Q: What ages qualify as a “child” on United?

A: Ages 2–11 (seat required), under 2 as “infant” (lap or seat), 12+ is adult for booking.

Q: Is there a fare difference for children?

A: Not on most U.S. routes; international sometimes has “child” rates 2–11—check six times with United.

Q: What about unaccompanied minors?

A: Ages 5–14 are UM; 15–17 optional; under 5, no solo travel—always six-agent confirmation.

Q: Documents needed?

A: Birth certificate/passport; six copies and verify at every stage.

Q: Boarding/bag rules for kids?

A: Under-2: early boarding, stroller check; kids 2–11 must sit in own seat, standard baggage; check six sources.
